Tasting Notes With our third vintage of Dry Stack Syrah we're beginning to get a clearer picture of what this vineyard is all about. We've seen it hot ('03 & '04) and we've seen it cool ('05) but certain characteristics shine through each year.

Aromas of cherries, dark plum and tobacco invite you in, followed by a palate of lively cherry infused with darker fruit undertones, a touch of smoky cedar and a silky, elegant mouthfeel. Delicious now (with 1-2 hours of decanting) the balance of fruit and acidity is delightful, making this a wine that should age wonderfully for years to come.
