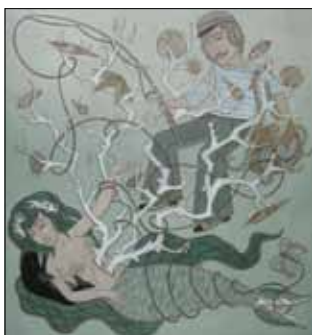

Tasting Notes | This is our second vintage of Windsor Oaks Pinot and we think we've crafted a wine of greater balance and structure compared to our inaugural '06. Garnet in color, the nose leads with strawberry, dark cherry and subtle pomegranate enhanced by nuances of brown sugar, rose petals and cigar box. Sweet dark cherry, black raspberry, cola nut and tobacco flavors are held together by good acidity and smooth, firm tannins. A celebration of big California fruit in a medium-bodied package with grace and style.
