Tasting Notes | A classic pale ruby, medium-red Pinot color, powerful aromatics of strawberry, cherry, cola-nut, baking spices and intriguing notes of rose petals, dried herbs and cigar box all jump out of the glass. Rich flavors of strawberry, red cherry, pomegranate and dark plum are balanced by a subtle earthy note and a luxuriant and silky texture. A vibrant, lively wine with excellent supporting acidity and wonderful intensity.
