Tasting Notes A light golden wheat color, this wine follows the lead of past Russian River Valley bottlings with aromas of poached pear, apple, tropical fruit and a spicy, floral accent. The palate offers sweet apple, lime, mineral, plus a touch of yeast, subtle oak and a creamy, mouth-coating intensity. If you have enjoyed this wine in the past, you should be very pleased with this rendition indeed. That said, greater acidity and structure will offer a longer cellar life and invite a bit more patience before opening your first bottle.
